*Appointed Persons are not required to hold a certificate. Suitable for very low-risk environments.

The above are the absolute minimum requirements, please remember that where injuries or illnesses may occur, they can be dealt with effectively and, in addition, if you have deemed a first-aider is unnecessary, there is still a possibility of accident or sudden illness, so you may wish to provide qualified first aiders.

Additional Recommendations:

- 1 trained first aider per shift (Emergency first aid, or full First aid at work)
- Lone workers may need first aid kits and remote support in case of emergency.
- Consider Mental Health/Paediatric First Aid (Visitors, customers)
